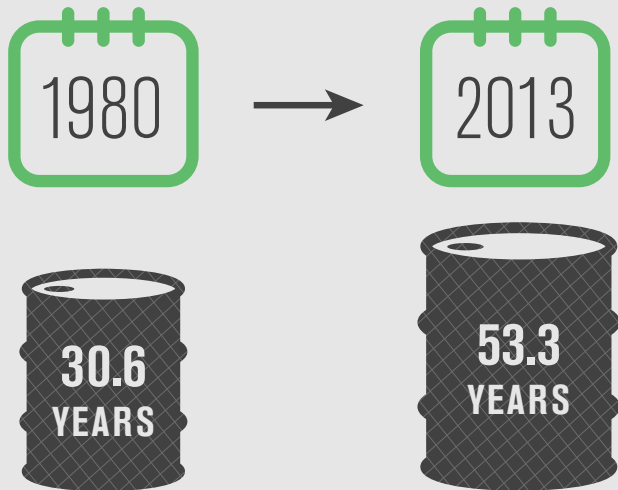


# Reducing our "dependence" on oil?

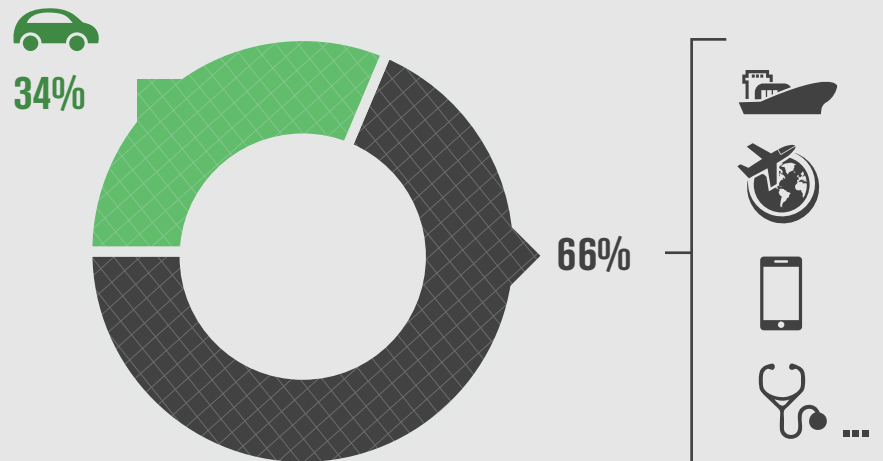
## Petroleum consumption snapshot

\*The ratio represents the number of years the actual proven reserves would last if production remains steady.

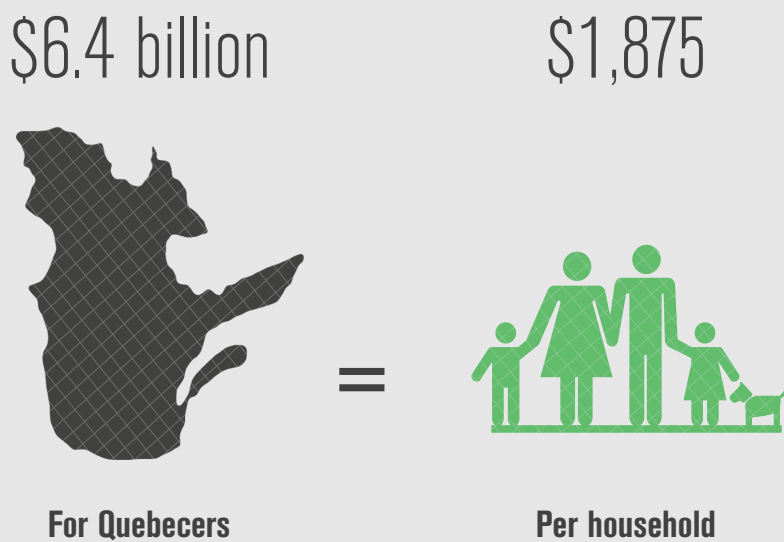
### Use of petroleum products

### Annual cost of proposed measures

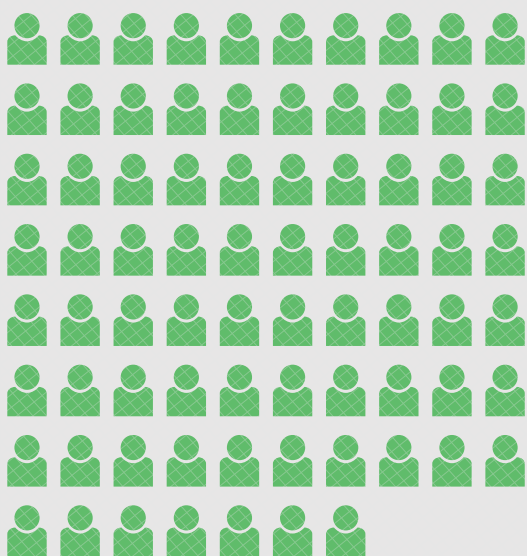


### The costs of subsidizing unsustainable "green" jobs

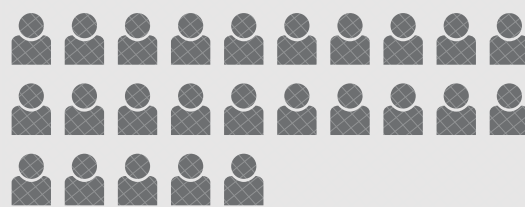


## Canadians don't want to pay the bill\*
